Criterion

"Student speak" Score (-/20)

Viewpoint: A clear opinion/statement is expressed in the thesis statement and throughout different writing sections with solid evidence/analysis.

makes a fair argument

Evidence: A variety of evidence is carefully selected by the writer. Any evidence in writing should be explained/analysed from multiple perspectives. (Historical Context, Audience, Purpose, Point of view, Reliability). Evidence should be relevant, reliable, and properly cited/acknowledged.

evidence is good, literally

Writing Structure & Analysis: The writer uses a clear and well-organised essay writing structure, convincingly arguing their point of view by analysing relevant evidence. In addition, the writer should also acknowledge existing or potential counter-claims and specify any limitations of research/analysis done by others and/or themselves.

"Student speak"

Language: The writer uses a strong, clear voice to engage the reader. Style and tone are appropriate to the writing, purpose, and topic. Correct and precise use of grammar, spelling, and punctuation are demonstrated.

good writing

Creativity & Complexity: The topic of research and discussion is novel and unique. If the topic itself is a very well-known writer's thesis/statement, creativity will be graded by the uniqueness and novelty of the writer's thesis.

The author has various ways to achieve the score of complexity based on the depth, intricacy, and sophistication of the thesis/analysis presented. For instance, if the author could connect their topic of research and statement to other events and theories in a different historical period or a distinct geopolitical region.
